Max Price took up the post of Vice-Chancellor of the University of Cape Town in July 2008. From 1996 to 2006, he was dean of the Faculty of Health Sciences at the University of the Witwatersrand. He has degrees from the Universities of the Witwatersrand (Medicine), Oxford (BA), and London (Public Health) and has published extensively in the fields of public health policy and health science education. Dr Price's professional work has included clinical work in hospitals and rural primary health care; he was a research fellow in health economics at the London School of Hygiene & Tropical Medicine (1986/7); and director of the Centre for Health Policy at Wits University. Amongst his awards are the Rhodes Scholarship, the Outstanding Young South African Award, an Honorary Fellowship of the Colleges of Medicine of SA, and the Takemi Fellowship in International Health at Harvard School of Public Health.
